WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK CLEARANCE

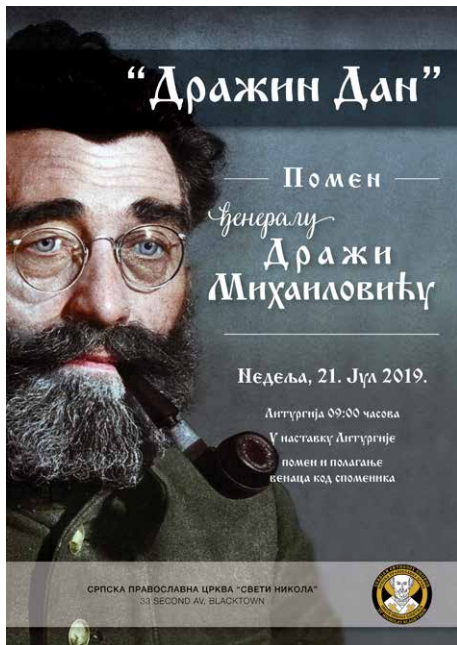

\$100 per one child per term

\$160 per two children per term

\$220 per three children per term
